
At the regular monthly meeting of this unit, on April 14, 2008, the club delegates present and voting, unanimously approved a motion to disaffiliate with PFSC until such time as PFSC ceases to be an affiliate of the National Wildlife Federation or the NWF publicly declares and disavows it's support for any and all United Nations aims and/or goals.

Enclosed you will find several of the reasons for this move. Our members are irate and outraged that NWF has moved to the extreme left of the political spectrum, using the names of sportsmen's organizations to enhance their prestige and influence to support aims and goals that are not in the best interests of the sporting community, not to mention the prerequisite that PFSC must obtain permission from NWF before affiliating with any other national organization.

While NWF and PFSC may have had mutual aims, goals and interests in the past, (like the Democratic party which is no longer the party of Roosevelt and Truman) it is no longer the same organization that many of PFSC's members find palatable, nor wish to be associated with.

It is with deep regret that this unit has come to this decision, after many years of mutual respect and cooperation. But now our members find that National Wildlife has, like the above mentioned Democratic party, become the organization that we, in good conscience, cannot support.

WHEREAS: NWF has adamantly refused to open their financial records which reveal organizations that are supporting them financially, and

WHEREAS: The above mentioned actions by NWF reflect upon PFSC by it's affiliation with NWF,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Pa. Federation of Sportsmens' Clubs terminate their affiliation with NWF until such time as NWF abandons it's above mentioned policies.
